The Natomas Central Mutual Water Company (Natomas) has reviewed the environmental document referenced above and, while having no comments on the document, would like to bring to your attention that a portion of the Woodland-Elverta Transmission Line study area (Component 6) falls within Natomas' service area. We wish to alert you and SMUD that possible conflicts could occur between the proposed transmission line and Natomas' existing facilities. In the event that LAFCo approves the annexation proposal, SMUD should be directed to work with Natomas during their siting of the proposed Woodland-Elverta transmission line to avoid or alleviate any negative impacts to Natomas' existing facilities.
