RE: Transfer of Jurisdiction to Yolo LAFCo (Yolo LAFCo 884)
Nishi/ Jury Multi-District Reorganization
Detachment from Solano Mosquito and Vector Abatement District;
Solano County Free Joint Library District; and Dixon Resource
Conservation District. Annexation to Sacramento-Yolo
Mosquito & Vector Control District; Yolo County Free
Joint Library District; and Yolo Resource Conservation District.

Approximately ten years ago, the Counties of Yolo and Solano made an adjustment to their boundaries of about 50 acres at the southern edge of the City of Davis. The change, known by the landowners names of Nishi and Jury, placed land expected to be annexed and developed by the City of Davis into Yolo County. However, years and politics passed and the land remains unincorporated. In the meantime, no cleanup of the special district boundaries has occurred.

The Yolo LAFCo recently worked with the East Davis Fire District and the Dixon Fire Protection District to detach Nishi-Jury from Dixon Fire Protection District and annex it to the East Davis Fire Protection District. However, as Elizabeth Kemper, Executive Officer of Yolo LAFCo, reviewed the area, she discovered that it is also still within the boundaries of the Solano Vector Control District, Solano Library District and the Solano Resource Conservation District. Yolo LAFCo will make application for the Nishi-Jury Multi-District Reorganization to the Yolo Board of Supervisors to clean up these boundaries.

Because Sacrament-Yolo Mosquito and Vector Control District is the largest entity in the proposed reorganization, and the majority of assessed valuation of that district lies within Sacramento County, the primary jurisdiction for the proposed reorganization is Sacramento County. Government Code Section 56388 allows the principal LAFCo to turn jurisdiction over to another LAFCo if both LAFCo's are in agreement. At the request

of Elizabeth Kemper and the Yolo Local Agency Formation Commission, I recommend your Commission transfer jurisdiction of the proposed Nishi-Jury Multi-District Reorganization to Yolo LAFCo.
