Transfer of Jurisdiction to Placer LAFCo

The Sacramento Local Agency Formation Commission has received an application for the annexation of five acres, by landowner petitioners Lee and Viorica Mosch, 6445 Cavitt Stalllman Road, Granite Bay, California, to the San Juan Water District. The parcel proposed for annexation, 035-050-041, is uninhabited, contiguous to the boundaries of San Juan Water District, and the District is able and willing to serve the territory. The proposal site is entirely within the boundaries of Placer County. A copy of the proposal is attached for your information.

RECOMMENDATION

I recommend that your Commission transfer jurisdiction of the proposed Mosch Annexation to San Juan Water District to the Placer Local Agency Formation Commission in accordance with Government Code 56388 which states:

The Commission of a principal county may vest jurisdiction in the county in which the territory proposed for a change of organization is located, if all of the following occur:

- a. The commission of the principal county agrees to having the exclusive jurisdiction vested in the commission of another county;
- b. The commission of the principal county designates the commission of another county which shall assume exclusive jurisdiction;
- c. The commission of the county so designated agrees to assume exclusive jurisdiction.
