## **DISCUSSION**

Recently, the Sacramento City Council and the County Board of Supervisors conducted separate workshops on the activity of the Natomas Joint Vision MOU. The workshops provided Councilmen and Supervisors with a progress update. The respective reports are attached for your information.

The major issues listed below were discussed during these meetings:

- 1. Progress/ Timing Issues
- 2. Definition of Open Space
- 3. Mitigation Ratios
- 4. Open Space/ Agricultural Mitigation Siting
- 5. SAFCA Flood Concerns

County staff reported that the City of Sacramento has not yet submitted a Sphere of Influence Amendment application nor started the environmental analysis on the Natomas Joint Vision Plan for submission to LAFCo.

City staff indicated staff is moving ahead on the Open Space/ Agricultural analysis. City staff will schedule a 2 x 2 City-County Committee meeting as well as a stakeholder meeting sometime during the next 90 days.

The Board of Supervisors requested County staff report back by August 23, 2006.

LAFCo staff continues to meet with City staff to coordinate the Sphere of Influence process.

As you recall, on May 4, 2005, the Commission authorized LAFCo to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Sacramento to act as co-lead agencies for the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report for adoption of a City General Plan Policies and LAFCo Sphere of Influence.
