DETERMINATIONS

There are six determinations required for staff to consider during the MSR process. Determination #7 is not required under state law but instead a local policy to serve the needs of the community being served by the agency. To maximize the MSR process, the Commission established that it is a priority to consider the regional needs unique to Sacramento County.




A MSR HELPS TELL THE STORY OF A MUNICIPALITIES CURRENT AFFAIRS

This timeline does not include MSRs for the seven cities within the County that are required to have updated MSRs. Staff will conduct MSRs for the cities on an individual basis, and will include a high-level summary to the Commission on how each city is functioning during the report back stage.

APPLICATION PROCESS

MSR Process Initiated MSR Application and Questionnaire Completed by District

MSR is Drafted by LAFCo Staff Or is Outsourced to a Consultant.

LAFCo staff will work with the agency on the best solution

LAFCo will check back in with the distrct/agency in approximatley 5 years or when another LAFCo project is required.

Final MSR Adopted

LAFCo Commission Reviews the draft MSR and will adopt by resolution the MSR if there are no issues.

MSR Provided to District for Review

At this point the MSR is administrative and is not a public document.



MSR provided back to LAFCo

LAFCo makes amendments as appropriate until a final draft is ready for the Commisson.

30-Day Public Review Period Closed



Public Review Period Opened

Commission reviews the MSR as a business item and releases the document for a 30-day public review period. At this time the MSR can be shared with a district's Board and made available on the website comments are welcomed.

BUDGET


Although it is hard to estimate how much a MSR costs to repair, it is helpful to prepare your district/jurisdiction's budget

MSR-SOI REORGANIZATION

The MSR-SOI helped support SacSewer and Regional San being reorgranized into one district, producing a more efficient utility service for staff and its customers.

MSR STUDY

MSR help determined some deficiencies in the District's operations and is supporting the conversation for a reorganization of the district.

MSR-SOI REORGANIZATION

An area of land is proposed to be annexed into the City of Sacramento and SacSewer's boundaries. The MSR is accompanied with a SOI to determine its feasibility from a growth perspective

<u>MSR-SOI</u>

MSR-SOI requested by the District. Helped discover that the District was not quite meeting Quimby standards.


